make mistakes...



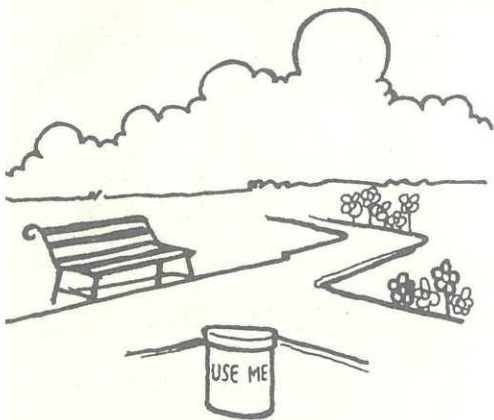
